Section 1. General Provisions

1.1. Name and Status

1.1.1. In accordance with the decision of the Khmelnytskyi National University Management an INTERNATIONAL VIRTUAL YOUTH BUSINESS HUB was created

is defined as a separate subdivision of the INTERNATIONAL VIRTUAL YOUTH BUSINESS HUB - COORDINATOR (IVYBHC) - Kyiv National University of Technologies and Design. This status allows IVYBH to effectively implement and develop international educational and cultural initiatives.

1.1.2. IVYBH is a full-fledged member of the VIRTUAL YOUTH BUSINESS HUBS INTERNATIONAL NETWORK, actively collaborating with other network members and adhering to its standards.
